- Who: Sunday Drive Art Projects. (Acceptable nickname: Sunday Drive)
- Sunday Drive Art Projects is a registered not-for-profit organization presenting arts events that bring new audiences to new places. Our projects increase the creation, presentation and dissemination of contemporary arts activities. We are a passionate group of arts professionals dedicated to nurturing cultural exchange and art activities around us. We believe contemporary art should be accessible to everyone.
- What: Art in unexpected places – “Sunday Drive presents Warkworth” is a 16-day arts festival that presents the work of artists in collaboration with the artist-run centres, collectives and alternative exhibitors that drive culture in metropolitan areas.
- Where: Warkworth, Ontario – about 1 ½ hours from Toronto.  
Bus transportation from downtown Toronto to Warkworth and back is available on the opening night of Saturday August 15th, Sunday August 16th and Saturday August 22nd.
- When: August 15th – August 30th  
**Opening kickoff – August 15th @ 6pm** with outdoor projection-based works beginning at 8pm. Closing at 11pm.
- When con’t: Regular Hours: August 15th - August 30th  
11am to 4:00pm – Wednesday to Sunday  
Closed Mondays and Tuesdays
- Why? To get out of the city and see a concentration of amazing art!  
The event brings together some of Toronto's most active arts presenters and artists to mount work in the beautiful village of Warkworth, temporarily transforming it into a hub of contemporary art. Works that are rarely seen outside of metropolitan centres take on a new life in the context of a rural setting.
